## QA It's OK to have questions. We have some answers.

### Q. Can I get COVID from the vaccine?

A. No. The vaccines do not use the virus in their manufacture. You cannot get the disease from the vaccine. You may experience some side effects, such as fatigue, headache, or muscle aches, but these are a sign your immune system is working to protect you.

### Q. Is the vaccine safe?

A. Yes. Vaccine safety was demonstrated in scientifically rigorous testing prior to receiving Emergency Use Authorization by the U.S. Food and Drug Administration. Through March 22, 126 million doses of the vaccine have been given in the U.S. The number of people experiencing serious adverse reactions is very low, between two and five people per 1 million vaccinations, or about 0.0005%!

### Q. How does a vaccine work?

A. The vaccine teaches your body what the spike-shaped protein of the coronavirus looks like. If you are later exposed to the virus, your immune system will be able to react quickly and effectively.

### Q. What about natural immunity?

A. Getting vaccinated is the quickest, safest, and most comfortable route to immunity. You can achieve immunity from getting the disease, but why play Russian Roulette with your life?

### Q. Has the COVID vaccine been proven effective?

A. Yes. Initial research demonstrated 80 to 90 percent effectiveness against moderate to severe COVID. Later research, conducted by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention in the "real world," has confirmed this effectiveness. (You can read the CDC research here: <https://bit.ly/31woR4y>)

### Q. Is vaccination free?

A. Yes. You will not receive a bill of any kind.

### Q. Will the vaccine change my DNA or cause fertility problems for me in the future?

A. The vaccine doesn't change or affect your DNA. It teaches your immune system how to fight off the disease. It will not affect your ability to get pregnant in the future.
